“PROJECT JAGRITI”

School-Based Cancer/Hepatitis-B/HIV/AIDS/Heart Attack & Juvenile Diabetes/Oral Hygiene

‘Care Promise Welfare Society’ is an ISO Certified organization dedicated to help one and all to understand dreadful diseases/responsibilities by holding awareness programmes in schools and communities. Interactive sessions are held with students and teachers in the morning assembly and as well as in the classrooms, using various types of communication material. The organization wants to help children better understand the impact of life threatening diseases & the bad effects it can have on them or on someone they know. Information is given to children keeping in mind their age groups in a very clear, simple and easy to understand language.



This year after getting approval from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan and Army Public Schools, our society has covered 606 Nos. of Schools involving more than 6 Lakhs No. of Students (Approx).

Special Orientation Programmes on dreadful diseases / importance of Girl Child/Rights of Women for School Teachers.

‘Care Promise Welfare Society’ also holds special orientation programmes on the above topics for school teachers. The objective of these programmes is to impart training to teachers on how to integrate awareness on these sensitive topics in the routine school course curriculum. Emphasis is also laid on how to develop and use various types of teaching aids to be used in awareness building activities. Sessions are mostly in interactive mode. These orientation programmes have also been found very useful in improving the teacher’s knowledge on this subject. This programme is normally conducted in the schools, immediately after the awareness programme for children.

This year we have trained more than 24000 teachers in various schools of India.

“PROJECT NARI SWABHIMAN”

Social Awareness Programme/Atrocities on Women/Mahila Panchayat

Women throughout the world suffer from all types of negligence, violence and exploitation. Lack of legal awareness among women is one of the main factors behind this. Our NGO decided to take steps in this direction by visiting houses in the near- by village Garhi, East of kailash, New Delhi and collect information from ladies in connection with the various kinds of Atrocities being faced by them under “PROJECT NARI SWABHIMAN”.

Though it was a very sensitive project but our team members carried out this exercise very successfully. Also the organization felt the need to organize local women under the platform of Mahila Panchayat. These women now feel more aware, confident and organized to fight against all types of exploitation.

Save the Girl Child Programme (PC & PNDT ACT, 1994)

Lack of information, awareness & unfounded belief are major obstacles restricting rural communities to reap the benefits of the many programs/schemes/activities of the various departments/agencies under Govt. of India, Govt. of Delhi and other Non- Govt. funding agencies.

Care Promise Welfare Society spread awareness in the schools, J J Colonies, Slums, RWA and Villages time to time through street plays, Nukkad-Nataks & counseling by our female staff on regular basis. The organization also distributes the leaflets in the community for awareness from time to time on this topic. Aim of these programs is to aware the youth and improvement in the birth rate of girl child.

We conducted 3 nos of street plays/ Nukkad Nataks to make the people aware about this problem , distributed leaflets in many areas in and around East of Kailash, Garhi village to educate the society-at-large, visited nos. of ultrasound clinics to make them aware about the importance and details of PC & PNDT ACT, 1994.

This has resulted in to direct benefit to around 1500 persons.

“PROJECT SWASTH- BHARAT”

Free Health Check-up Camps

In our Indian Society Set-up, people do not feel the need of visiting hospitals unless there is a compulsion from health point of view.

Keeping the above reason in mind, our NGO keep on visiting different areas of Delhi/ NCR to conduct free health check-up camps under “Project Swasth Bharat” to identify those persons who need a thorough medical check-up.

This year we conducted 50 health check-up camps at various locations directly benefiting more than 15000 Males and Females.

We have a team of dedicated doctors available at short notice for delivering educative lectures on such subjects & for health camps etc.

Some of the locations where we have conducted health check-up camps this year are as follows:-

- a) Lajpat Nagar, New Delhi*
- b) Garhi, New Delhi*
- c) Nangla Gujran, Faridabad, (Haryana)*
- d) Village SamayPur, Rohini, Delhi*

Our Society keep on getting the references/details of many Cancer patients while visiting various schools, conducting free health check-up camps or through kind hearted donors. Sometimes the cases of patients are directly referred to us by various hospitals. Most of the patients are in dire need of finances because of the prohibitive cost of Cancer treating medicines/medical tests/Chemotherapy etc.

We try to help to the maximum possible depending upon the donations received by our NGO for such poor patients.

This year we have helped more than 65 Cancer patients.
