Brief account of the activities of the organization since inception

"Care Promise Welfare Society" is a 15 years old registered ISO certified

National level NGO which plays an important role in the development of our society. We Endeavour for making good living conditions of under-privileged, uneducated and destitute people. As per our Central Government policies which thrust upon the Upliftment of the downtrodden and vulnerable section of the society, it is the N.G.O.s who executes the various Government programmes and thus play a significant role in achieving the Social objective of our constitution.

Foundation:-

The welfare society was formed on 12th July, 2002 by Dr. M.K. Dubey, a Resident of Lucknow. The basic reason for this act of nobleness was the fact that his father died of cancer. He then decided to serve & form the society and thus the NGO was formed. Since then the society is Working For The Poor Cancer, Hepatitis & AIDS Patients/Women Victims/Poor Students & Generating Awareness about Dreadful Diseases specially patients belonging to 'below poverty line' category across India by providing them financial and moral support. We then expanded slowly adding other activities as per the MOA of the society & added our branches at Mumbai, Lucknow, Jaipur, Chandigarh, Kangra & Jammu in different states all over India.

We are running five main projects namely:

- ▶ PROJECT JAGRITI- To generate awareness about Cancer, Hepatitis-B & AIDS (only to senior students) etc. in various schools of India. Covered 92 Lakhs school children in more than 9500 schools directly and about 1.7 crore adults indirectly.
- ➤ PROJECT SHIKSHIT BACHPAN- To help poor BUT bright students and/ or whose at least one of the parents has died due to Cancer/AIDS. At present 300 students are getting help.
- ➤ PROJECT SAHARA- Financial help to poor & under-priveledged patients affected by dreadful diseases. Provided financial help to more than 3000 patients with almost Rs. Three crore till date.
- ➤ PROJECT SWASTH BHARAT- To organize Free Health Check-up Camps under community health programme. Have organized more than 500 camps so far.
- ➤ **PROJECT NARI- SWABIMAN** Identifying and helping poor women affected by Atrocities. Also working on "Save the girl child project under PC & PNDT, 1994". 50 such families are getting help on monthly basis.

We are also active in the following fields:

- > Awareness on cancer and AIDS through stage and street plays.
- Conducting and attending seminars and workshops.
- Networking with other NGOs.
- > Running two **charitable dispensaries**.
- Running a call center to educate and help the poor patients affected by dreadful diseases.
- We are planning to purchase and start a Cancer detection mobile van.
